The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

1. Generally, sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities were observed at Navotas Fish Port this week.Commodities recorded were tulingan, chabeta, tambakol, dalagang bukid, hasa-hasa, and others. Relatively, adequate availability of local fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), was recorded sourced from Palawan and Zambales. More specifically, four (4) brokers offered the commodity on 19 September 2023 and five (5) brokers on 22 September 2023.

- 2. Available supply of frozen galunggong lalaki (Decapterus macrosoma) and frozen galunggong babae (Decapterus ruselli) were still recorded in the fish port this week, both were imported from China.
- 3. Meanwhile, no unloading of alumahan (Rastrelliger kanagurta) were still observed at the fish port this week.
- 4. For bangus and tilapia, sufficient availability were still recorded at the fish port this week. On the other hand, large-sized bangus was still observed to be the majority of display chiefly sourced from Bulacan and Pangasinan.
- 5. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
- a. Bangus -Bulacan
- b. Tilapia Batangas
- c. Local Galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
- d. Alumahan- Not available
- e. Imported galunggong China
- (-) Price and Volume not available during price monitoring

Remarks/Market Observations:

- (**) Actual Price price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring.
