Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- The presence of Typhoon "Jenny" and the Southwest monsoon in most parts of the country continued to bring rainy and cold weather conditions (i.e., partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms) in the country. As a result, a minimal display of fresh marine commodities was still noted this week at the wholesale level.
- Consequently, minimal volume of supplies for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) were unloaded at the fish port this week. Higher wholesale price was noted for local-fresh galunggong at Php200.00/kg due to lesser supplies this week. Most of the unloaded supplies were 12-28pcs/kg. There are other local variants like galunggong "balsa" and "burot" recorded.
- Supplies of imported-frozen galunggong continuous to be recorded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. The prevailing wholesale price is still at Php145 & 145/kg imported from China.
- For bangus, relatively high wholesale price were still observed for the past few weeks. Nonetheless, supplies remained sufficient to cater the demand from the consumers.
- Same prevailing wholesale price were still noted for tilapia at Php120.00/kg this week. This may be attributed to the sufficient and stable supply at the market.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
 - Alumahan- NA
 - Imported galunggong - China
