Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities was noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Commodities recorded were kitang, pogita, dorado, batalay, saramulyete, sap-sap, pusit bisayas, labahita, and others.
- Consequently, for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong laki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), adequate volume of supplies was unloaded at the fish port. However, higher wholesale price were noted for local-fresh galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*) at Php180.00/kg this week.
- For imported-frozen galunggong, continuous supply were still noted at Navotas Fish Port this week. The prevailing wholesale price of the commodity was at Php140 & 145/kg imported from China and Vietnam.
- Higher wholesale price were also noted for bangus and tilapia at Php140.00/kg and Php120.00/kg this week. According to vendors, most of the wholesale price of fishery commodities increased.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Zambales, Palawan, Quezon
 - Alumahan- NA
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam, China

Note: Wholesale price data is on September 12, 2023 is as of September 9, 2023, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the interval cut off of the covering period of this report.

 (**) - Actual Price - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market.
