The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- 1. At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities was noted this week. Commodities recorded were dalagang bukid, bisugo, lapulapu, olpot, pusit, lapad, alakaak, batalay, tambakol, labahita, and others.
- 2. For medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (Decapterus macrosoma), ample volume of supplies were still unloaded at the fish port. Lower wholesale price was noted for local-fresh galunggong at Php120.00/kg due to higher supplies this week. Supplies recorded were 15-22pcs/kg. Other local variant like galunggong "balsa" and "burot" were also recorded.
- 3. Continuous supply were recorded for imported-frozen galuggong at Navotas Fish Port this week. The prevailing wholesale price was still at Php140 & 145/kg imported from China and Vietnam.
- 4. Increase in the wholesale price for bangus were observed for the past few weeks. Nonetheless, supplies remained sufficient to cater the demand from the consumers.
- 5. For tilapia, no changes were noted in the prevailing wholesale price at Php120.00/kg this week. This may be attributed to
- the sufficient and stable supply at the market. 6. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
- a. Bangus Bulacan, Pangasinan
- b. Tilapia Batangas, Pampanga
- c. Local galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
- d. Alumahan- NA
- e. Imported galunggong China

Note: Wholesale price data is as of September 23 & 26, 2023, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.
