| Remarks/Market Observations <p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of September:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Overall, adequate supplies of fresh marine commodities were observed among the monitored retail markets this month. However, minimal unloading's were reported by the vendors during the first week of the month wherein supplies might be affected by the occurrence of Typhoon "Hanna" on August 30 - September 3, 2023 and Tropical Depression "Ineng" on September 4-5, 2023. Meanwhile, availability of local fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) remained adequate in the monitored markets throughout month. Supplies of other variants were also recorded including galunggong babae (<i>Decapterus ruselli</i>), galunggong balsa (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), and galunggong burot (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>). Supply of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki and galunggong babae were consistently available in the monitored markets this month sourced mainly from Navotas Fish Port. Display of other imported-frozen commodities were also recorded (i.e., pampano, Chub mackerel, salmon, and pusit kalawang). Sufficient availability of alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) was also noted this month. However, large-sized of the commodity was still the majority of supplies available in the monitored markets sourced from Lucena (Quezon), Malabon and Navotas Fish Port. Likewise, sufficient supplies of aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia) were recorded this month. Nonetheless, it was reported by the vendors that their is an increased in the wholesale price of bangus. Other vendors opted not to increased their price as the demand continued to be lower. For tilapia, majority of the display noted in selected markets were sourced from Pampanga due to its cheaper price as compared to the supply from Batangas. Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan Tilapia - Batangas Local Galunggong - Navotas and Malabon Fish Ports Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port and Lucena (Quezon) Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *<i>Scomberomorus commerson</i> or Tangigue (Sliced) - (Php400.00 & 750.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php400.00/kg noted in fourth week of the month wherein supplies recorded were not in good quality (supplies from previous days). Highest prevailing price of Php750.00/kg was noted in the second week where supplies recorded were in good quality and sourced from Lucena, Quezon. *<i>Epinephelus</i> spp. or Lape-lapu (Black) - (Php300.00-550.00/kg)- lowest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg was noted in the fourth week of the month wherein supplies were observed to be smaller as compared to the supplies recorded in the first week of the month which was observed to be larger size, hence offer relatively higher. *<i>Epinephelus</i> spp. or Lape-lapu (Red) - (Php500.00, 550.00, 600.00/kg)- lowest prevailing price of Php500.00/kg was noted in the first and second week of the month wherein supplies were observed to be smaller as compared to the supplies recorded in the third and fourth week of the month which was observed to be larger size, hence offer relatively higher. *<i>Caesio caerulaurea</i> or dalagang bukid bilog (Php280.00-380.00/kg) - Similarly, lowest prevailing price of Php280.00/kg was noted in the third week of the month wherein supplies were observed to be smaller as compared to the supplies recorded in the fourth week of the month which was observed to be larger size, hence offer relatively higher. *<i>Coryphaena</i> spp. or Dorado - (Php230.00 & 440.00/kg)- lowest prevailing price of Php230.00/kg was observed in the First week of the month wherein the supply recorded are reportedly offer in whole or "buohan". Meanwhile, highest recorded price of Php440.00/kg was noted offer in sliced cut, hence the high price. *<i>Leiopotherapon plumbeus</i> or Ayungin (Php240.00-360.00/kg)- The difference in the price were due to the quality of the commodity, wherein the supply of lowest prevailing price of Php. 240.00/kg was stocks from previous market days and the highest prevailing price of Php360.00/kg was good in quality. *<i>Octopus vulgaris</i> or Pugita - (Php90.00 - 200.00/kg) - both prevailing price were observed in Navotas Fish Port (retail), wherein, lowest prevailing price of Php 90.00/kg was noted in the fourth week of the month wherein supplies were noted low in quality compared to the supplies recorded in the first week of the month which was observed to have better quality (in terms of freshness), hence offer relatively higher price. *<i>Pterocaesio digramma</i> or Dalagang bilog- (Php260.00-380.00/kg)- lowest prevailing price of Php. 260.00/kg was observed in both primary market(i.e., Mega-Q and Maypajo Calococan Public Market) which was recorded in the first week of the month. Meanwhile, highest recorded price Php. 380.00/kg was noted in secondary markets (i.e., Tandang Sora and Mandaluyong market). *<i>Sillago sihama</i> or Asohos (Php300.00-400.00/kg)- lowest prevailing retail price of Php300.00/kg noted in the third week of the month was observed low quality in terms of freshness (remaining stocks from previous market day), hence the lower price. On the other hand, the highest recorded price of Php400.00/kg was noted in the fourth week of the month which was reported to have better quality in term of freshness, resulting to offer in a higher price. *<i>Trichiurus japonicus</i> or Espada (Php300.00-400.00/kg)- Similarly, difference in price were attributed due to the quality of the commodities, wherein, lowest prevailing retail price of Php300.00/kg noted in the second week of the month was observed low quality in terms of freshness (remaining stocks from previous market day), hence the lower price.
