

## The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- 1. At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), minimal volume and variety of marine fishery commodities (i.e., lapad, bakoko, silinyase, kabase, bidbid, matambaka, dilis, gulyasan, galunggong babae, burot etc.) was noted this week.
- 2. Nonetheless, adequate volume of supplies for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) were still unloaded at the fish port this week. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php200.00/kg. Other local variants like galunggong "balsa" and "burot" were observed.
- 3. According to the report from Fisheries Inspection and Quarantine Division (FIQD) on 17 October 2023, a total of 21.85 MT of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki from 2022 was still available in the cold storages at Navotas Fish Port Complex. Even so, no availability of the commodity was recorded at Navotas monitored markets this week. According to Ms. Joyce Velasquez, Fisheries Market Operations Officer III of Navotas Fish Port Complex, the unavailability of imported-frozen galunggong at Navotas could possibly be due to the recent conduct of monitoring and confiscation of imported-frozen galunggong on 13 October 2023 at Navotas wet markets by Navotas LGU authorities. This is in preparation for the upcoming importation under FAO 259, hence, some of the fish vendors at the fish port were hesitant to display imported-frozen galunggong.
- 4. The wholesale price of bangus is at Php140.00/kg sourced mainly from Bulacan this week. Supplies remained sufficient and stable to cater the demand from the consumers.
- 5. For tilapia, no changes was recorded in the prevailing wholesale price at Php110~&~120.00/kg this week. This may be attributed to the sufficient and stable supply at the market.
- 6. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
- a. Bangus Bulacan, Pangasinan
- b. Tilapia Batangas, Pampanga
- c. Local galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
- d. Alumahan- NA
- (-) Price and Volume not available during price monitoring
- (\*\*) Actual Price price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market

This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring.
