**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), sufficient volume of marine fishery commodities were still observed this week. Commodities recorded include betilya, pusit, bisugo, silinyase, lapad, gulyasan, tambakol, chabeta, dalangang bukid, and others. For medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), supplies remained available at the fish port at prevailing wholesale price of Php160.00/kg. These supplies were chiefly sourced from Zambales. Also, other variants of the commodity like galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) and burot (*Decapterus kurroides*) were available at the fish port.
- Meanwhile, supplies of medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki from China resumed at Navotas Fish Port this week. The recorded prevailing wholesale price was at Php140.00/kg.
- Supplies of alumahan remained unpredictable as no unloading was reported at Navotas Fish Port today.
- For medium-sized bangus, most of the supplies available at Navotas Fish Port were from Bulacan while supplies from Pangasinan were dominantly large (1-2pcs/kg) this week.
- Lastly, for medium-sized tilapia, adequate volume of supplies was noted at Navotas Fish Port this week with a recorded wholesale price of Php120.00/kg chiefly sourced from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local Galunggong- Zambales
  - Alumahan- Not Available
  - Imported galunggong - China

(\*\*) - Actual Price - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring.
