<b>Remarks/Market Observations</b>	<p><b>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of October:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Minimal display of fresh marine commodities were noted among the monitored retail markets during the 1st to 3rd week. This may be due to the the presence of Typhoon "Jenny" and the Southwest monsoon in most parts of the country continued to bring rainy and cold weather conditions (i.e., partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms) during the 1st week. Adequate supplies of fresh marine commodities were noted among the monitored retail markets during the 4th week of the month</li> <li>For local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decaterus macrosoma</i>), supply remained ample among the monitored retail markets this month. This resulted to the a stable prevailing retail price at Php200.00/kg for this month. Higher prices were noted during 1st to 2nd week of the month due to the continuous rainfall brought by Typhoon which resulted to limited supplies. Other local galunggong variants like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>) and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) were recorded in some of the monitored retail markets this month.</li> <li>More supplies of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (<i>Decaterus macrosoma</i>) were noted this month. This may be attributed to the approved Certificate of Necessity to Import 35,000MT of frozen roundscad, mackerel, bonito and moonfish for wet markets on which started last 1 October 2023 and shall only be valid on 31 December 2023. Most of the vendors still prefer selling local-fresh galunggong lalaki due to higher demand from consumers. The prevailing retail price is at Php150.00 &amp; 200.00/kg this month. Other imported-frozen commodities like pampano, salmon mackarel, salmon, chabeta, pusit kalawang, and tulingan were present in the markets.</li> <li>For medium-sized alumahan, the prevailing retail price decreased at Php240.00/kg this month. According to vendors, supplies remained adequate among the monitored retail markets. Most of the available supplies were larger sizes and sourced mainly from Lucena and Navotas Fish Port.</li> <li>No changes were noted in the prevailing retail prices of bangus and tilapia at Php180.00/kg and Php130.00/kg this month due to the stable and sufficient supplies at the monitored markets. There are still some vendors who prefer selling larger size of bangus due to the higher demand from consumers. There is still a Php20-30/kg price difference between live and fresh-chilled tilapia.</li> <li>Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga</li> <li>Local Galunggong - Navotas Fish Ports, Lucena Quezon</li> <li>Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port</li> </ol> </li> <li>Low influx of buyers were still observed among the monitored markets this month. As a result, fish vendors are coping by selling lower volume of supplies and limited varieties of fishery commodities to ensure that all supplies are sold out by the end of the day. Meanwhile, some fish vendors are opening on an alternate day schedule or during market days (Friday-Sunday) where there are more people in the monitored markets.</li> </ol>

Highest prevailing price of Php400.00/kg was also noted in the 1st and 3rd week at Malabon Market where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Pterocaesio Chrysozona</i> or Dalagang Bukid - Bilog - (Php260.00 - 360.00/kg) - lowest recorded price of Php260.00/kg was observed in primary market (i.e., maypajo Public Market) wherein supply are usually sourced directly from its nearby wholesale market (i.e., Malabon Fish Port) .
