The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of October:

- The presence of Typhoon "Jenny" and the Southwest monsoon in most parts of the country continued to bring rainy and cold weather conditions (i.e., partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms) in the country during the 1st week resulting to a minimal display of fresh marine commodities at the wholesale level. Ample unloading of fresh marine commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) during the 4th week of the month. Among the commodities recorded were lapad, bakoko, silinyase, kabase, bidbid, matambaka, dilis, gulyasan, galunggong babae, burot and others.
- The prevailing wholesale price for local-fresh galunggong was noted at Php160.00/kg this month. Adequate supplies of local-fresh galunggong were unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port this month. Supplies were mainly sourced from Palawan, Quezon Province and Zambales.
- For imported-frozen galunggong, the supplies increased due to the approve Certificate of Necessity to Import 35,000MT of frozen roundscad, mackerel. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php145.00/kg this month. Imported-frozen galunggong babae was available at the fish port this month.
- Same prevailing wholesale prices were recorded for aquaculture commodities like bangus and tilapia this month. According to vendors, the available supplies remained sufficient to cater the demand of consumers.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Palawan, Zambales, Quezon Province
 - Imported-frozen galunggong - China

(**) - Actual Wholesale - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring
