The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- 1. At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), minimal but sufficient volume of marine fishery commodities was noted this week. Among the commodities recorded were betilla, dalagang bukid, batalay, saguese, loro, labahita, talakitok, etc. Meanwhile, unloadings of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was also recorded with a prevailing wholesale price of Php160.00/kg, all were sourced from Zambales. Other variant of local galunggong ie., burot (*Decapterus kurroides*) was also recorded at the fish port.
- 2. Display of imported-frozen galunggong was also noted at the Fish Port this week sourced from China.
- 3. For alumahan, no unloading of the commodity was noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.

Remarks/Market Observations:

4. For medium-sized bangus, steady and adequate volume was noted at Navotas Fish Port this week. The recorded prevailing wholesale price were Php130.00 & 140.00/kg. Supplies were sourced from Bulacan. Meanwhile, large-sized bangus sourced from Pangasinan was notable at the fish port. 5. Likewise, for medium-sized tilapia, adequate availability of the commodity was reported at Navotas Fish Port this week. Hence, the recorded
