Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Sufficient volume of marine fishery commodities was observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Commodities recorded were labahita, dalagang bukid, talakitok, gulyasan, tambakol, lapad, malakapas, and others.
- For local-fresh galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*), despite the ongoing Closed Fishing Season for local galunggong in Northern Palawan (major fishing ground), supplies sourced from Zambales and Mindoro was reported at the fish port this week. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php180.00/kg. There are other local variants like galunggong "balsa" and "burot" were observed.
- Due to the minimal supply of local-fresh galunggong, more supplies of imported-frozen galunggong were available at the Navotas Fish Port this week. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php130.00/kg. Supplies were imported from Vietnam.
- No changes were noted in the prevailing wholesale prices of both medium-sized bangus and tilapia at Php140.00/kg and Php110.00/kg, respectively. This may be attributed to the stable and sufficient supplies unloaded at the said fish port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Zambales, Mindoro
 - Alumahan- NA
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam

 (**) - Actual Price - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring.
