Remarks/Market Observations			<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of November:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Overall, lower supplies of fresh marine commodities were noted among the monitored retail markets this month. This may be attributed to the low volume of catch from major source areas caused by: a.) implementation of Closed Fishing Season in Visayan Sea for sardines, herrings, and mackerels on November 15, 2023, and b.) effects of heavy rainfall in the Eastern parts of the Southern Luzon and Visayas during the 4th week of the month. For local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>), lesser supplies were observed among the monitored retail markets this month due to the implementation of Closed Fishing Season for galunggong in Northern Palawan (major source area) on 1 November 2023. This resulted to a higher prevailing retail price at Php280.00/kg for this month. There are other local galunggong variants like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>) and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) recorded in some of the monitored retail markets this month. Higher volume of supplies for imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) were observed due to the low supply of local galunggong this month. The prevailing retail price is at Php240.00/kg this month. Some of the vendors prefer selling imported-frozen galunggong due to its cheaper price making it easier to sell. Other imported-frozen commodities like pampano, salmon mackerel, salmon head and belly, chabeta, pusit kalawang, and tulingan were noted in the monitored markets. The prevailing retail prices of bangus and tilapia remained stable at Php160.00/kg and Php130.00/kg this month. This may be due to the stable and sufficient supplies among the monitored markets. Most of the supplies for bangus and tilapia were still sourced from Bulacan & Pangasinan and Pampanga & Batangas, respectively. Some vendors in Muñoz, Trabajo, Tandang Sora, Mega-Q, and Galas markets prefer selling larger size of bangus due to the higher demand from consumers. There is still a Php20-30/kg price difference between live and fresh-chilled tilapia. Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga Local Galunggong - Navotas Fish Ports, Lucena Quezon Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port Low influx of buyers were still observed among the monitored markets this month. As a result, fish vendors are coping by selling lower volume of supplies and limited varieties of fishery commodities to ensure that all supplies are sold out by the end of the day. Meanwhile, some fish vendors are opening on an alternate day schedule or during market days (Friday-Sunday) where there are more people in the monitored markets. Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <p>* <i>Sepioteuthis lessoniana</i> or Pusit Lumot - (Php400.00 - 500.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php400.00/kg were recorded in the 2nd and 4th week at Guadalupe, Calocan, Munoz, and Malabon Retail Market where supplies were sourced directly from Fish Port and were not in good quality (supplies from previous days), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php500.00/kg was also noted in the 1st and 3rd week at Kamuning, Mandaluyong, Marikina, and Farmers Market where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Coryphaena</i> sp. or Pandawan - (Php140.00 & 440.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php140.00/kg were recorded in the 3rd week at Navotas Retail Market where supplies were sourced directly from Navotas Fish Port, hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php440.00/kg was noted in the 2nd week at Polo Market where supplies recorded were in good quality and sourced from Lucena, Quezon.</p> <p>* <i>Nematalosa nasus</i> or Kabasi - (Php100.00 & 300.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php100.00/kg were recorded in the 2nd week at Pasig Market where supplies were not in good quality (supplies from previous days), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg was noted in the 2nd week at Malabon Market where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Pterocasio Chrysozona</i> or Dalagang Bukid - Bilog - (Php260.00 - 360.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php260.00/kg were recorded in the 5th week at Quinta Market where supplies recorded were not in good quality (supplies from previous days). Highest prevailing price of Php360.00/kg was also noted in the 1st week at Kamuning Market where supplies recorded were in good quality and sourced from a primary market, hence, the higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Selaroides leptolepis</i> or Salay-Ginto - (Php240.00-360.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php240.00/kg were recorded in 3rd and 4th week at Pasig, Polo, Mega-Q and Commonwealth Markets wherein supplies were recorded to be small-size. Highest prevailing price of Php360.00/kg was also noted in the 1st and 2nd week at Commonwealth, Kamuning, Mandaluyong, Tandang-Sora, and Guadalupe Markets where supplies recorded were large-size.</p>
