The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of November:

- Generally, minimal unloading of fresh marine fishery commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. Among the commodities recorded were dalagang-bukid bilog, balsa, labahita, tanigue, maya-maya, dorado, gulyasan, bitilya, saramulyete, and others.
- For local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), the prevailing wholesale price was recorded at Php160.00/kg this month. According to vendors, lesser local galunggong were observed especially during the later weeks (4th and 5th) of the month which resulted to higher wholesale price. This may be attributed to the implementation of Closed Fishing Season for local galunggong (*Decapterus* spp.) in Northern Palawan on November 1, 2023 to January 31, 2024. Supplies available were mainly sourced from Zambales, Southern Palawan, and Quezon Province.
- It was observed that there is an increase in the supply of imported-frozen galunggong this month as a substitute commodity for local galunggong. This may be due to the approval of Certificate of Necessity to Import 35,000MT of frozen roundscad, mackerel for the period of October 1 to December 31, 2023. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php140.00/kg. Imported-frozen galunggong babae was available at the fish port this month.
- The actual wholesale price of alumahan is at Php180 & 190.00/kg this month. Lower volume of supply of alumahan was observed in the fish port due to the implementation of Closed Fishing Season for sardines, herrings, and mackerels in Visayan Sea on November 15 to February 15.
- No changes were recorded in the prevailing wholesale prices of aquaculture commodities like bangus and tilapia this month. This may be due to the stable and sufficient supplies at the said fish port.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Zambales, Quezon Province, Southern Palawan
 - Alumahan - Panay gulf, Masbate
 - Imported-frozen galunggong - China, Vietnam
