Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Ample unloading of marine fishery commodities was observed in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Likewise, for medium-sized local fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), supplies were sufficient. The recorded prevailing wholesale price was Php180.00/kg. Said supplies were sourced from Bataan, Palawan, Mindoro, Zambales, and Zamboanga.
- Availability of medium to large-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki from China and Vietnam continued to be observed at Navotas Fish Port this week.
- For alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*), minimal unloading was noted at said fish port this week, sourced from Palawan.
- Sufficient unloading of bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) was noted in the fish port this week. In fact, no major changes were recorded in the prevailing wholesale prices of both commodities.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities in the monitored wholesale market are as follows:
 - Bangus -Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong- Zambales, Bataan
 - Alumahan- Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam

Note: Wholesale price data used on 08 February 2024 is as of 07 February 2024 as daily price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut-off time.

(**) - Actual Price - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring.
