The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- At Navotas Fish Port, adequate unloading of marine fishery commodities was observed this week. Commodities recorded were bisugo, torcillo, gulyasan, lapad, dalagang bukid, tambakol, silinyase, and others. More specifically, for local-fresh galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*), supply sourced from Zamboanga, Zambales, and Mindoro were noted in the fish port. This week's prevailing wholesale price was at Php180 & 200.00/kg.
- For the imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) continuous supply were still notable at Navotas Fish Port imported from China and Vietnam. The prevailing wholesale price of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was Php130/kg, while for galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) the recorded actual price was Php88 and 90/kg.
- Sufficient supply of aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia) was observed at Navotas Fish Port this week. In fact, no significant changes were noted in the prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized bangus and tilapia at Php150.00/kg and Php100.00/kg, respectively, this week. This may be due to the stable supply from the major source areas at the said fish port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Zambales, Zamboanga, Mindoro
 - Alumahan- Bataan
 - Imported galunggong - China and Vietnam
