The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of January: 1. Overall, minimal unloading of fresh marine commodities was observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. This could be due to the unfavorable weather condition brought about by the shear line affecting the eastern section of Southern Luzon and Northeast Monsoon (Amihan) in parts of the Northern and Central Luzon as reported by PAGASA. 2. For local-fresh galunggong (Decapterus macrosoma), limited volume sourced from Zamboanga, Zambales and Southern Palawan were noted at Navotas Fish Port this month This may be attributed to the ongoing Closed Fishing Season for local galunggong in Northeastern Palawan (major fishing ground) from November 1, 2023 to January 31, 202-The prevailing wholesale price was at Php180 & 200/kg. 3. Higher demand for imported-frozen galunggong were noted at the fish port due to the limited supply of local galunggong. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php180 & 200/kg. 3. Higher demand for imported-frozen galunggong were noted at the fish port due to the limited supply of local galunggong. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php180.00, Supplies were imported from Vietnam and China. Imported-frozen galunggong babae was available at the fish port this month. 4. The actual wholesale price of alumahan is at Php140.00/kg this month. Lower volume of supply of alumahan was observed in the fish port due to the ongoing implementati of Closed Fishing Season for sardines, herrings, and mackerels in Visayan Sea on November 15 to February 15. 5. For aquaculture commodities like bangus and tilapia, no changes were recorded in the prevailing wholesale prices at Php140 & 150/kg (for bangus) and Php100/kg (for tilapia) this month. This may be due to the stable and sufficient supplies at the said fish port. 6. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas: a.
