GENERAL CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a natural-born Filipino citizen;
- Any high school graduate or graduating student;
- Not more than 25 years old at the time of the examination, who has not earned any units in college;
- Graduating student with HONORS, duly certified by the school head/ principal;
- For high school graduate applicants who completed their high school under the old curriculum, the general weighted average (GWA) shall not be lower than 80%;
- For graduating students GWA of the last 3 immediately preceding semesters of his Senior High School in any Track shall not be lower than 80% or its equivalent
- Of good moral character as certified by the school head;
- Parent(s)/guardian or the applicant must be physically residing in the municipality of the region for at least six (6) months, where the slot of the scholarship program is allotted.
