




| Remarks/Market Observations: | | <p>The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of February:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Overall, increased unloading of fresh marine commodities compared last month was observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. This could be due to the lifted implementation of Closed Fishing Seasons (CFS) in Northeastern Palawan (major fishing ground) on 1 February 2024, as well as in Visayan Sea on 16 February 2024. For local-fresh galunggong (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>), sufficient volume sourced from Palawan, Mindoro, Zambales, Bataan, and Zamboanga City was observed at Navotas Fish Port. This may be attributed to the lifted CFS for local galunggong (<i>Decapterus</i> spp.) in Northeastern Palawan (major fishing ground) on February 1, 2024. The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized galunggong was Php160.00/kg. For imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (<i>D. macrosoma</i>), supplies remained notable at Navotas Fish Port this month. Said supplies were imported from Vietnam and China. Other variant of the commodity like imported-frozen galunggong babae (<i>D. russelli</i>) was also recorded. For alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>), more supplies were observed at Navotas Fish Port this month. This might also be influenced by the lifted CFS for sardines, herrings, and mackerels in Visayan Sea last 16 February 2024. Supplies available in the fish port were derived from Masbate and Palawan. For aquaculture commodities like bangus (<i>Chanos chanos</i>) and tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>), stable and sufficient supplies were still observed at Navotas Fish Port. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan & Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas & Pampanga Local-fresh galunggong - Palawan & Zambales Alumahan - Masbate Imported-frozen galunggong - China, Vietnam | | | | | | | | |
