The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of March:

1. Overall, sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities were observed among the monitored retail markets this month. Local fresh galunggong lalaki (Decapterus macrosoma) was consistently available from various sources, including Farmers Market (wholesale), Malabon Fish Port, Navotas Fish Port, Lucena (Quezon), Palawan, and Romblon. This could be could be due to unhindered fishing operations due to favorable weather conditions. Additionally, there was an increase in the display of fishery commodities during the second week of the month, with some vendors anticipating higher demand due to the observance of Ramadan.

^{2.} In contrast, limited availability was noted for medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (D. macrosoma) as the local variants remained sufficient. However, large-sized imported galunggong was present in Quinta, Guadalupe, Caloocan, and Polo Public markets.

^{3.} Adequate supply were also observed for medium-sized alumahan (Rastrelliger kanagurta) throughout the monitored retail markets this month. Availability of other variants such as Hasa-hasa was also noted.

^{4.} Furthermore, supplies of bangus (Chanos chanos) and tilapia (Oreochromis niloticus) remained sufficient among the monitored markets this month. For bangus most supply were sourced from Bulacan and Pangasinan, and tilapia mainly sourced from Batangas and Pampanga. 5. Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:

a. Bangus - Bulacan

b. Tilapia - Batangas

c. Local Galunggong - Navotas and Malabon Fish Ports d. Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port

e. Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port
