<p><b>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of April:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Overall, sufficient supply of fresh marine commodities was observed among the monitored retail markets this month. According to the fish vendors, slight increase in the variety of species was observed in the monitored markets. This might possibly be due to the fair-weather condition.</li> <li>Consequently, sufficient supply of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) was noted in the monitored retail markets this month. In fact, supplies from Palawan, Romblon and nearby Provinces in Northeastern Palawan were observed available in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) to the monitored retail markets throughout the month. The recorded prevailing retail price of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki was Php200.00/kg and Php240.00/kg. Other local galunggong variants like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>) and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) were also recorded in some of the monitored retail markets.</li> <li>Even though supplies of local-fresh galunggong-lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) were adequate, supply of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki were still recorded in the monitored retail markets this month. However, decreasing availability of frozen variants were observed due to the steady and adequate supply of local-fresh variants. The prevailing retail price of medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong was Php190.00/kg this month. Other imported-frozen commodities like galunggong babae, pompano, salmon head, belly, meat and pusit kalawang were noted during monitoring.</li> <li>For tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>), stable and sufficient supply was still observed among the monitored retail markets this month. The recorded prevailing retail price of medium-sized tilapia remained at Php140.00/kg. There is still Php20-30/kg price difference between live and fresh-chilled tilapia.</li> <li>For bangus (<i>Chanos chanos</i>), constant supplies from major source areas like Pangasinan and Bulacan were observed among the monitored retail markets this month. The recorded prevailing retail price of medium-sized commodity was steady at Php180.00/kg. Nonetheless, some fish vendors in Muñoz, Trabajo, Galas, and Tandang Sora markets prefer selling larger size bangus due to higher demand from consumers.</li> <li>Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga</li> <li>Local Galunggong - Navotas Fish Ports, Malabon Fish Port, Lucena Quezon</li> <li>Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p>Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Penaeus monodon</i> - Hipon (Jumbo to Large 15 pcs and below) – (Php510.00-Php1440.00) - lowest prevailing price of Php510.00/kg were recorded at Maypajo Caloocan Market where supplies were not in good quality (supplies from previous days), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php1440.00/kg was noted at Pqsig Market where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price. Both highest and lowest recorded prevailing price was observed on the third week of April.</li> <li><i>Scylla serrata</i> – Alimango (Female) – (Php650.00-Php1200.00) – lowest prevailing price was recorded on third week of April at Marikina Market where supplies were not in good quality (supplies from previous days), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php1440.00/kg was noted at Farmers Market on First week of April where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price.</li> <li><i>Portunus pelagicus</i> – Alimasag (Large size 1-6pcs.) (Php280.00-Php570.00) - lowest prevailing price of Php280.00/kg were recorded at Guadalupe Market where supplies were not in good quality (supplies from previous days), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php570.00/kg was noted at Marikina Market where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price. Both highest and lowest recorded prevailing price was observed on the Third week of April.</li> <li><i>Thunnus albacares</i> – Yellowfin tuna (Sliced) (Php300.00 &amp; Php400.00) - lowest prevailing price was recorded on third and fourth week of April were increase volume of supplies were observed on this week. Highest prevailing retail price were recorded on first and second week of April, were supply volume of supply was minimal, hence higher prevailing price.</li> <li><i>Katsuwonus pelamis</i> – Gulyasaan (Sliced) (Php300.00 &amp; Php400.00) - Lowest prevailing price was recorded on first and second week of April were increase volume of supplies were observed on this week. Highest prevailing retail price were recorded on third and fourth week of April, were supply volume of supply was minimal, hence higher prevailing price.</li> <li><i>Scomberomorus commerson</i> – Tangigue (Whole) (Php320.00 – Php600.00) - lowest prevailing price of Php320.00/kg were recorded at Malabon Central Market where supplies were not in good quality (supplies from previous days), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php600.00/kg was noted at Guadalupe Market where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price. Both highest and lowest recorded prevailing price was observed on the third week of April.</li> <li><i>Sepioteuthis lessoniana</i> - Lumot (Php300.00 – Php500.00) - lowest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg were recorded at Maypajo Market where supplies were not in good quality (supplies from previous days), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php500.00/kg was noted at Marikina Market where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price. Both highest and lowest recorded prevailing price was observed on the third week of April.</li> <li><i>Lutjanus</i> sp. - Maya-maya - (Php400.00 &amp; Php600.00) - lowest prevailing price of Php400.00/kg were recorded at Marikina Market where supplies were not in good quality (supplies from previous days and smaller in size), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php600.00/kg was noted at Guadalupe Market where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price. Both highest and lowest recorded prevailing price was observed on the third week of April.</li> </ol> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Acanthurus</i> sp. – Labahita – (Php120.00 – Php400.00) - lowest prevailing price of Php120.00/kg were recorded at Malabon Central Market where supplies were not in good quality (supplies from previous days), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php400.00/kg was noted at Mandaluyong Market where supplies recorded were in good quality, hence, the higher price. Both highest and lowest recorded prevailing price was observed on the third week of April.</li> <li><i>Caesio cuning</i> – Dalagang-bukid lapad – (Php180.00-Php480.00) - lowest prevailing and highest price of Php180.00/kg and Php480.00/kg were recorded at Pasig Mega Market on third week of April, 2024.
