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Remarks/Market Observations:	<p>The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of April:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Overall, sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities was observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month . Consequently, there's still abundant supply of local-fresh galunggong (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) observed in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. Said supply was sourced from Palawan and Zambales. The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized galunggong was Php120.00/kg. These were sourced from Batangas, Zamabales and Northern Palawan. Even with ample supply of local-fresh galunggong-lalaki (<i>D. macrosoma</i>), continuous availability of imported-frozen variant was still available in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. The said imported supply was derived from China and Vietnam. Other variant like imported-frozen galunggong babae (<i>D. russelli</i>) was also recorded. For alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>), minimal availability of the commodity was recorded this month. The reason for this could be due to the unprofitable unloading of supplies observed at the fish port. The recorded actual wholesale price was Php**180.00/kg and Php220.00/kg. Said supplies were primarily sourced from Batangas, Zambales and Northern Palawan. For aquaculture commodities like bangus (<i>Chanos chanos</i>) and tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>), stable and sufficient supplies were still observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan & Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas & Pampanga Local-fresh galunggong - Palawan & Zambales Alumahan - Masbate Imported-frozen galunggong - China, Vietnam
