**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Overall, sufficient unloading of marine fishery commodity at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) was observed this week even after the observance of Holy Week last week. For medium-sized local-fresh galunggong-lalaki (*Decapterus macrossoma*), sufficient availability of the commodity sourced from Northern Palawan and Zambales with prevailing wholesale price of Php140.00/kg and Php160.00/kg. Variants of galunggong such as burot (*D. kurroides*) and babae (*D. russelli*) were also recorded.
- Even with the constant availability of local galunggong, supplies of medium to large-sized imported- frozen galunggong-lalaki continued to be evident in Navotas Fish Port this week. Said supplies were imported from China and Vietnam at prevailing wholesale price of Php120.00/kg and Php130.00/kg.
- For aquaculture commodities such as bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*), supplies were consistently available at Navotas Fish Port this week. The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized bangus and tilapia were Php130.00/kg and Php80.00/kg & Php90.00/kg, respectively.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local galunggong- Northern Palawan
  - Alumahan - Bataan
  - Imported galunggong - Vietnam, China
