Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- In general, ample volumes were noted for fresh marine commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- There is still abundant supply of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) reported this week. This may be attributed to the good weather condition. The prevailing wholesale price remained relatively low at Php120.00/kg this week. Supplies were mainly sourced from Northern Palawan and Zambales. There were also other variant of local galunggong like burot (*Decapterus kurroides*) and balsa (*Decapterus macarellus*) recorded at the fish port.
- Supply of imported-frozen galunggong were still available at the fish port despite the abundant supplies of local-fresh galunggong. However, according to vendors, most of the buyers prefer local than imported. The prevailing wholesale price of imported-frozen galunggong was at Php120 & 130/kg sourced from China and Vietnam.
- For bangus and tilapia, same prevailing wholesale prices at Php120-140/kg and Php120/kg, respectively were noted this week. This may be due to the sufficient and stable supplies unloaded at the fish port. According to vendors, some of them decrease their selling price to compete for the price of marine commodities which is lower this time of the year.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
 - Alumahan- Palawan, Bataan
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam, China
