**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Ample unloading of fresh marine commodities was still observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Among the commodities recorded were alakaak, lapu-lapu, tanigue, biluan, bagaong, kabase, gulyasan, tambakol, dalagang bukid lapad & bilog, and others. More specifically, adequate unloading of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was observed at the fish port. The recorded prevailing wholesale price was Php120.00 & 140.00/kg. These supplies were sourced from Zambales, Quezon Province, and Northern Palawan. Other variant of the commodity (i.e., galunggong babae, *D. russelli*) were also reported.
- On the other hand, availability of medium to large-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*D. macrosoma*) and galunggong babae (*D. russelli*) imported from China and Vietnam were still observed at Navotas Fish Port this week. The recorded prevailing wholesale prices were Php120.00/kg and Php80.00/kg, respectively.
- For alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*), only one (1) broker unloaded the commodity at the Navotas Fish Port this week. The recorded actual wholesale price was Php 160.00/kg, sourced from Bataan.
- Constant availability of bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) was observed in the Navotas Fish Port this week. In fact, no major changes in the prevailing wholesale price of both commodities were recorded.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities in the monitored wholesale market are as follows:
  - Bangus -Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local Galunggong- Zambales and Northern Palawan
  - Alumahan- Bataan
  - Imported galunggong - Vietnam, China
