Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of June:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Generally, there was ample availability of fresh marine commodities in the monitored retail markets this month. However, a minimal supply of these commodities was observed in the fourth week, likely due to hampered fishing operations caused by rainy weather conditions across the country. Nonetheless, adequate availability of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) was noted across all monitored retail markets. These supplies were mainly sourced from Malabon Fish Port and Navotas Fish Port. Other local galunggong variants such as "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>), and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) were also observed in some of the monitored retail markets. Due to the constant availability of local galunggong variants, only minimal quantities of medium to large-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki were observed this month. Other imported-frozen commodities such as galunggong babae, pompano, salmon head & belly, and pusit kalawang were noted in most of the monitored markets. In contrast, there were minimal displays of medium-sized alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) noted in the monitored markets this month. However, the supply of large-sized alumahan remains evident, mainly sourced from Malabon and Navotas Fish Port. Additionally, hasa-hasa (<i>Rastrelliger brachysoma</i>) was displayed during the price monitoring activities. Meanwhile, aquaculture commodities such as bangus (<i>Chanos chanos</i>) and tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>) showed consistent and adequate supply across all monitored markets this month. According to vendors, most buyers still prefer bangus sourced from Pangasinan due to its premium quality over bangus sourced from Bulacan. Similarly, for tilapia, they prefer Batangas over those from Pampanga due to the commodity's superior taste quality.
