Remarks/Market Observations	<p><b>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of May:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For fresh-marine commodities, stable availability was observed among the monitored retail markets in the National Capital Region this month. Supplies from the wholesale markets (i.e., Navotas fish port, Malabon fish port, and Farmers wholesale market) continuously sufficient, which supplied the retail markets nearby.</li> <li>Relatively, sufficient display of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) is still observed in the monitored retail markets this month. In fact, supplies from Palawan, Zambales, Batangas and Quezon Province were observed available in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) which filled the need of this commodity in the nearby retail markets. The recorded prevailing retail price of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki was Php200.00/kg. Other local galunggong variants like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>) and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) were also recorded in some of the monitored retail markets.</li> <li>Supplies of medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki was still observed in some of the monitored retail markets this week, this is despite of adequate availability of medium-sized variety. Some retail markets tend to sell medium-sized galunggong lalaki variant due to its uniform sized, which favored their buyers/consumers from food stalls (<i>carinderia</i>). The prevailing retail price of medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong was Php190.00/kg this month. Other imported-frozen commodities like galunggong babae, pompano, salmon head, belly, meat and pusit kalawang were also noted this month.</li> <li>For tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>), continuous availability from the source areas Pampanga and Batangas supplies the retail markets in Metro Manila this month. The recorded prevailing retail price of medium-sized tilapia was Php130.00/kg. There is still Php10-30/kg price difference between live and fresh-chilled tilapia.</li> <li>Likewise for (<i>Chanos chanos</i>), constant supplies from major source areas like Pangasinan and Bulacan were observed among the monitored retail markets this month. The recorded prevailing retail price of medium-sized commodity was steady at Php160.00/kg. Nonetheless, some fish vendors in Muñoz, Trabajo, Galas, and Tandang Sora markets prefer selling larger size bangus due to higher demand for consumers.</li> <li>Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga</li> <li>Local Galunggong - Navotas Fish Ports, Malabon Fish Port, Lucena Quezon</li> <li>Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p>Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Uroteuthis bartschi</i> - Lapis (Php300.00/kg - Php450.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg was observed at Kamuning Market on the third week of the month where supplies were not in the good quality (supplies from previous market days). Highest actual price of Php450.00/kg was noted Galas Market where supplies are in the best quality (newly unloaded supplies), hence, the higher price.</li> <li><i>Glossogobius celebius</i> - Biya (Php200.00/kg - Php500.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg at Malabon Central Market where supplies were sourced directly from nearby Fish Port (e.g., Malabon Fish Port), hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php500.00/kg was noted at Pasig Market where supplies are in premium quality, hence, the higher price. Both prices was observed on the third week of May, 2024.</li> <li>Hemiramphus sp. - Salurasid (*Php140.00/kg and Php360.00/kg) - lowest actual price of Php140.00/kg was observed at Balintawak Market on the second week of the month where supplies were sourced directly from nearby Fish Port (e.g., Navotas Fish Port), hence, the lower price. Highest actual price of Php360.00/kg was noted in secondary markets at Kamuning Market on the third week of the month, where supplies are source only from the primary market not in the fish port, hence, the higher price.</li> </ol>
