Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Overall, sufficient unloading of marine fishery commodities was observed at Navotas Fish Port this week. Among the marine commodities recorded were batalay, saguese, betilla, tulingan, dalagang bukid, lapad, tamban, and others. For local-fresh galunggong lalaki, supplies remained available at Navotas Fish Port with recorded prevailing wholesale prices of Php120.00/kg. These supplies were sourced from Zambales and Palawan. Other variants of galunggong like galunggong babae were also noted.
- For imported-frozen galunggong, supplies continued to be evident at Navotas Fish Port this week. The recorded prevailing wholesale price of galunggong lalaki and babae was Php120.00/kg and Php80.00/kg, respectively.
- For alumahan, only one (1) broker unloaded the commodity on May 28 & 30, 2024 at Navotas Fish Port with recorded actual wholesale price of Php160.00 & 233.00/kg, sourced from Bataan and Panay Gulf.
- For aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia), supplies remained stable and sufficient in all the monitored markets this week. For medium-sized bangus (*Chanos chanos*), the recorded wholesale prices remained at Php130.00/kg for supplies sourced from Pangasinan and Php110-120.00/kg for supplies sourced from Bulacan. For medium-sized tilapia, steady supplies were noted in the monitored wholesale markets this week. The recorded prevailing wholesale price was Php90.00/kg, from Batangas and Pampanga.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities in the monitored wholesale market are as follows:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong- Zambales and Northern Palawan
 - Alumahan- Bataan, Panay Gulf
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam, China
