Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- An ample unloading of marine fishery commodities was observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Among the marine commodities recorded were matangbaka, gulyasan, dalagang bukid, silinyase, betilla, labahita, batalay, tamban, and others. For medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), the recorded prevailing wholesale price was Php120.00 and Php130.00/kg. These supplies were sourced from Zambales and Northern Palawan. Another variant of galunggong like (*D. russelli*) galunggong babae and (*D. kurroides*) burot was also noted.
- Despite the constant unloading of local galunggong variants, availability of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki remained evident at Navotas Fish Port this week. The recorded actual wholesale price was at Php120.00/kg.
- For medium sized alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*), supplies continued to be unpredictable as no unloading of the commodity observed this week at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale).
- Lastly, aquaculture commodities such as bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) remained abundant in Navotas Fish Port market. The recorded prevailing wholesale price of medium-size bangus was at Php110.00 & Php115.00/kg mainly sourced from Bulacan and Pangasinan. On the other hand, the prevailing wholesale price of tilapia was at Php95.00 & 100.00/kg sourced from Pampanga and Batangas.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities in the monitored wholesale market are as follows:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong- Zambales and Northern Palawan
 - Alumahan- Masbate
 - Imported galunggong - China and Vietnam
