Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of August:

- Generally, an adequate supply of various fresh marine commodities were recorded at the Navotas Fish Port this month. For medium-sized local fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrostoma*), supplies remained consistently available at the Fish Port. Supplies were mostly sourced from areas including Zambales and Northern Palawan. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php120 & 160/kg this month.
- Unloadings of medium-sized imported frozen galunggong lalaki (*D. macrostoma*) remained available despite the availability of local galunggong. Other imported commodities like galunggong babae (*D. russelli*) was also observed. The prevailing wholesale price was at Php 115 & 120/kg and were mainly sourced from Vietnam and China.
- Minimal unloadings of medium-sized alumahan were reported during the 2nd and 4th week at fish port. Only actual prices of Php125-215/kg were recorded this month.
- For Bangus and Tilapia, sufficient and stable unloadings were still reported at the Navotas Fish Port this month. Most of the supplies were recorded from Bulacan, Pangasinan and Batangas, Pampanga.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan, Zambales
 - Imported-frozen galunggong - Vietnam, China
 - Alumahan- Northern Palawan, Masbate
