Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of July:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Generally, there was ample availability of fresh marine commodities in the monitored retail markets during the first and second weeks of this month. However, a decrease in supply was observed on the third and fourth weeks, likely due to disrupted fishing operations caused by rainy weather from severe Tropical Storm "Carina," which affected most parts of the country from July 19-25, 2024. Despite this, local fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrossoma</i>) was available across all monitored retail markets throughout the month. These supplies were mainly sourced from Malabon Fish Port and Navotas Fish Port. Other local galunggong varieties, such as "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>), and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurraides</i>), were also observed. Despite the consistent availability of local galunggong varieties, medium to large-sized imported frozen galunggong lalaki was still observed at Maypajo Caloocan Market this month, sourced from Navotas Fish Port. This could be because vendors preferred the imported commodity due to its affordable price, which made it easier for them to sell. Other imported frozen commodities, such as galunggong babae, pompano, salmon head and belly, and pusit kalawang, were also observed in most of the monitored markets. Adequate display of alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) were seen in the monitored markets this month. However, large-sized alumahan was the majority of the supply, mainly sourced from Malabon and Navotas Fish Port. Additionally, hasa-hasa (<i>Rastrelliger brachysoma</i>) was consistently available in the monitored markets. On the other hand, for aquaculture commodities like bangus (<i>Chanos chanos</i>) and tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>), consistent and an adequate supply across all monitored markets this month. However, a price difference between bangus from Bulacan and Pangasinan was observed in which bangus from Pangasinan generally has a higher retail price because buyers prefer its superior quality over supplies from Bulacan. Similarly, the retail price of tilapia from Batangas is higher compared to those from Pampanga, as most of the vendors preferred this due to its higher quality (in terms of taste).
