Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of July:

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), an adequate supply of various fresh marine commodities was observed in the first week of this month. However, a decrease in the unloading of these commodities were noticed from the second to the fourth week, while a slight increase in supply reported in the fifth week. This is likely due to disrupted fishing operations caused by rainy weather from severe Tropical Storm "Carina" which affected most parts of the country from July 19-25, 2024. Despite this, the unloading of local fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was consistently recorded at the Fish Port, sourced from various areas including Zambales, Northern Palawan, Zamboanga, and Batangas.
- Meanwhile, the unloading of imported frozen galunggong lalaki (*D. macrosoma*) and babae (*D. russelli*) was still observed at the fish port this month, mainly sourced from Vietnam and China.
- For alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*), there was a limited unloading of the commodity at the fish port this month and mainly sourced from Northern Palawan and Zamboanga. An actual prices were recorded from the third to the fifth week.
- For aquaculture commodities, an ample delivery of medium-sized bangus (*Chanos chanos*), sourced from Bulacan and Pangasinan, was observed at the Fish Port this month. Similarly, supplies of medium-sized tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) remained sufficient, sourced from Batangas and Pampanga.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen galunggong - Vietnam, China
 - Alumahan- Northern Palawan
