Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- An increase in the unloading of fresh marine commodities was observed at Navotas Fish Port this week. However, according to the fish vendors, higher prices of some commodities were still noted in the wholesale market. More specifically, an adequate supply of local fresh galunggong lalaki was noted, sourced from Zambales and Palawan.
- Despite the sufficient supply of local fresh galunggong, supplies of imported-frozen galunggong were still recorded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). The prevailing wholesale price of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki was Php115/kg & 120/kg while Php85/kg for imported-frozen galunggong babae, both were derived from China and Vietnam.
- No significant changes were observed in the prevailing prices of medium-sized bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) this week at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), where the supply remained stable and adequate.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
 - Alumahan- Not available
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam, China
