Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- This week, stable availability of fresh marine commodities was noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). However, an increased in the prevailing wholesale price of local fresh galunggong-lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was recorded on August 30, 2024, following the onset of the Southwest monsoon affecting Metro Manila and most part of Luzon.
- On the other hand, unloading of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*D. macrosoma*) and galunggong babae (*D. russelli*) were recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). The actual wholesale price of the said commodity was Php120.00/kg & Php125.00/kg while Php90.00/kg was noted for imported-galunggong babae.
- For alumahan (*Rastriliger kanagurta*), only one unloading of this commodity were observed this week at actual wholesale price of Php215.00/kg sourced from Northern Palawan.
- For aquaculture commodities bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*), stable unloading of supply was still recorded this week.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Laguna, Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
 - Alumahan- Norther Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam, China
