**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Lesser unloading of fresh marine commodities were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. This could be attributed to the hampered fishing operations due to unfavorable weather conditions brought by the Southwest monsoon or "Hanging Habagat" in the country.
- In relation, limited display local-fresh galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*), was recorded this week. The recorded actual wholesale price was at Php130.00/kg sourced from Northern Palawan.
- In contrary, adequate supplies of imported-frozen galunggong variants were recorded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). The prevailing wholesale price of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki remained at Php120/kg while Php85/kg was noted for imported-galunggong babae, both were derived from China and Vietnam.
- For medium-sized bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*), supplies remained steady and sufficient at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
  - Local galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
  - Alumahan- Northern Palawan
  - Imported galunggong - Vietnam, China

*Note: No wholesale price data on July 19, 2024, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut-off time*
