Remarks/Market Observations	<p><b>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of February:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Overall, sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities was observed this month. However, minimal volume of fresh marine commodities was recorded on the first and third week due to the occurrence of Typhoon "Enteng" and Tropical Depression "Gener", respectively. On the other hand, sufficient volume of supply was achieved in the second and forth week due to fisherfolk taking advantage during periods without gale warnings, allowing them to continue fishing and support their livelihoods.</li> <li>For local-fresh galunggong-lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>), supply remained consistently available in all the monitored retail markets this month. Moreover, the prevailing retail for medium-sized variety was Php260.00/kg, sourced from different origin such as Navotas, Malabon, Farmers, Lucena, Palawan, Romblon, and Zambales.</li> <li>Even though supplies of local galunggong variants were adequate, supply of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki were still recorded in the monitored retail markets this month. The prevailing retail price of medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong was Php190.00/kg. Other imported-frozen commodities like galunggong babae, pompano, salmon head, belly, meat and pusit kalawang were also noted in the monitored markets.</li> <li>Minimal availability of medium-sized alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanugarta</i>), was still observed in all the monitored retail markets this month. This could be due to the unpredictable unloading of supplies from the wholesale markets (i.e., Navotas and Malabon Fish Port).</li> <li>For tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>), stable and sufficient supply was still observed among the monitored retail markets. The recorded prevailing retail price of medium-sized tilapia remained at Php140.00/kg this month. There is still Php20-30/kg price difference between live and fresh-chilled tilapia.</li> <li>For bangus (<i>Chanos chanos</i>), constant supplies from major source areas were still observed among the monitored retail markets this month. The recorded prevailing retail price of medium sized commodity was steady at Php180.00/kg.
