For alumahan (Rastrelliger observed in the forth week rebserved in the forth week rebse	following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of September:  Inerally, sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities were observed in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale market) this month. However, minimal volume of fresh marine commodities was reded on the first and third week of the month due to the occurence of Typhoon "Enteng" and Tropical Depression "Gener", respectively. On the other hand, sufficient volume of supply was eved in the second and forth week due to fisherfolk taking advantage during periods without gale warnings, allowing them to continue fishing and support their livelihoods. Meanwhile for itum-sized local-fresh galunggong-lalaki, supplies continuously available in the wholesale market at Php120.00/kg-Php230.00/kg sourced from different source areas such as Bicol, hern Palawan, Quezon Province, and Visayan Sea.  Intinuous unloading of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (D. macrosoma) and babae (D. russelli), remained notable at Navotas Fish Port this month. Said supplies were reported from a at prevailing wholesale price of Php125.00/kg and Php90.00/kg, Php120.00/kg, respectively.  In alumahan (Rastrelliger kanagurta), unpredictable availability was still observed this month. Despite minimal availability recorded on the first three weeks, increased unloading was rived in the forth week recorded to have prevailing retail price of Php147.00/kg to Php233.00/kg, sourced from Quezon Province, Visayan Sea, and Palawan.  In aquaculture commodities bangus (Chanos chanos) and tilapia (Oreachromis niloticus), stable and sufficient supplies were still observed at Navotas Fish Port this month. Spite Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:  Bangus - Bulacan & Pangasinan  Tilapia - Batangas & Pampanga  Local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan & Zambales  Alumahan - Quezon Province  Imported-frozen galunggong - China
