Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Due to the inclement weather condition brought by super typhoon "Julian", lesser supplies of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- For medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), higher prevailing wholesale price at Php280.00/kg were observed especially during the later part of the week. Most of the supplies were sourced from Mindoro and Palawan. There were other variants of local galunggong, such as galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) and burot (*Decapterus kurroides*) observed in the fish port.
- There were no recorded supplies of imported-frozen galunggong at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- For aquaculture commodities like medium-sized bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*), same prevailing wholesale price were noted at Php 120/kg and Php100/kg this week. This may be attributed to the stable and sufficient supplies unloaded for both of the commodities.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Mindoro, Palawan
 - Alumahan- NA
 - Imported galunggong - NA
