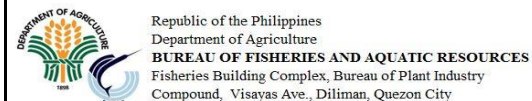

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Low volume of supplies for fresh marine commodities were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. This may be attributed to the hampered fishing operation and disruption of trading and logistics of marine commodities coming from nearby regions, caused by inclement weather over the past few days due to the Southwest monsoon (*Habagat*) and tropical depression "*Gener*", and Tropical Storm "*Helen*".
- For local-fresh galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*) minimal supplies were also unloaded at the fishport this week with a recorded actual wholesale price of Php120.00/kg sourced from Zambales. However, no available supplies were recorded on 20 Sep 2024.
- No supplies were available for imported-frozen galunggong "lalaki" (*Decapterus macrosoma*) at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. However, supplies of imported-frozen galunggong "babae" (*Decapterus russelli*) were observed.
- No changes in the prevailing wholesale prices were observed for aquaculture commodities such as bangus and tilapia this week. The prevailing wholesale prices of medium-sized bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) remained at Php120 & 130/kg and Php 100/kg this week. This may be due to the stable and sufficient unloadings at Navotas Fish Port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan, Laguna
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Laguna
 - Local galunggong- Zambales
 - Alumahan- Not available
 - Imported galunggong - NA

 (**) - Actual Wholesale Price - refers to the prices in the absence of the most frequently occurring value per fresh fishery commodity per sampling size at a given time.
