Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. As recorded, three (3) brokers unloaded supplies of medium-sized local fresh galunggong laki (*Decapterus macrossoma*) on 24 September 2024 with a recorded prevailing wholesale price of Php 120.00/kg sourced from Zambales and Palawan. Meanwhile, five (5) brokers unloaded supplies of the commodity on 27 September 2024 with a recorded prevailing wholesale price of Php230.00/kg derived from Palawan and Zambales.
- Continuous unloading of imported frozen galunggong variants was still recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) despite the availability of local galunggong this week. More specifically, for imported frozen galunggong laki (*Decapterus macrossoma*), the actual wholesale price was at PHP 150.00/kg, while the prevailing wholesale price of imported galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) was at PHP 120.00/kg; both were sourced from China.
- Similarly, unloadings of alumahan (*Rastriliger kanagurta*) were recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week, offered at the prevailing wholesale price of Php147.00-233.00/kg sourced from Quezon Province, Visayan Sea, and Palawan.
- Adequate unloadings of bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) were noted this week at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). For medium-sized bangus, the prevailing wholesale price was Php 130.00/kg obtained only from Bulacan. Nonetheless, available unloading of small and large-sized bangus was noted sourced from Batangas, Laguna, Bulacan, and Pangasinan. Ample unloading of small, medium, and large-size tilapia was also noted this week, sourced from Pampanga and Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Palawan and Zambales
 - Alumahan- Quezon Province
 - Imported galunggong - China
