Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Adequate unloading of fresh-marine commodities was observed this week at Navotas Fish Port wholesale market. In fact, varieties of captured marine-commodities such as tambakol, gulyasan, bisugo, dalagang-bukid and etc., were recorded. Consequently, for the medium-sized local-fresh galunggong-lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), maintained and stable availability at Php200.00/kg sourced from Palawan and Zambales was also observed this week.
- Despite sufficient availability of local-fresh galunggong-lalaki, continuous supply of imported-frozen galunggong variant was still observed at Navotas Fish Port wholesale market this week. The recorded prevailing wholesale price of imported-frozen galunggong-lalaki and babae was Php140.00/kg and Php120.00/kg, respectively. Said supplies was sourced from Vietnam.
- For aquaculture commodities bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*), adequate unloading of supply was still recorded this week.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Palawan, Zambales
 - Alumahan- Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam
