**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Limited unloading of supplies for fresh marine commodities were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. This may be attributed to the rainy weather condition brought by Typhoon "Kristine", which hindered any fishing activity throughout the affected areas in the country.
- Moreover, minimal volumes of supplies were noted for local-fresh galunggong this week.
- Supplies of imported-frozen galunggong increased due to the limited supplies of local-fresh galunggong. The recorded prevailing wholesale price of imported-frozen galunggong-lalaki was at Php140.00/kg sourced from Vietnam.
- For Bangus (*Chanos chanos*), a prevailing wholesale price of Php 100.00/kg was noted this week. This may be attributed to the smaller sizes of the commodity unloaded, with the recorded sizes primarily being small to medium (3-5 pieces per kilogram). Supplies were mostly sourced from Laguna.
- For tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*), supplies remained steady and sufficient at the Navotas Fish Port this week. The prevailing wholesale prices was recorded at Php100.00/kg. Supplies were mostly sourced from Pampanga.

5. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:

- Bangus - Laguna, Pangasinan
- Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
- Local galunggong- Zambales
- Alumahan- NA
- Imported galunggong - Vietnam
