Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Generally, a limited volume of fishery commodities was recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Specifically, only 363.152 metric tons were noted on 29 October 2024, compared to the supplies on 22 October 2024, which were 826.423 metric tons. Likewise, there were limited supplies of medium-sized local fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), with only one (1) broker unloaded on 29 October 2024. The recorded actual wholesale price was Php 160.00/kg, sourced from Zambales.
- Unloading of imported frozen medium-sized galunggong lalaki (*D. macrosoma*) was also recorded at the fish port this week, sold at a prevailing wholesale price of Php 150.00/kg, while imported galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) was sold at Php 145.00/kg, both sourced from Vietnam.
- Meanwhile, no unloading of medium-sized alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*) was observed at Navotas Fish Port this week.
- Sufficient availability of bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) was noted this week at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). For medium-sized bangus, the prevailing wholesale price were Php 120.00/kg, sourced from Bulacan and Laguna. Moreover, supplies of large-sized bangus were also recorded at the fish port, sourced from Pangasinan, Bulacan, and Batangas. For medium-sized tilapia (*O. niloticus*), the prevailing wholesale price was Php120.00/kg, predominantly sourced from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Laguna
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Zambales
 - Alumahan- Not available
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam

Note: No price monitoring activity was conducted on November 1, 2024 due to the observance of All Saints day.

(**) - Actual Price - refers to the prices in the absence of the most frequently occurring value per fresh fishery commodity per sampling size at a given time.

NA- Source Area not available during price monitoring

Note: Wholesale price data of bangus, tilapia, alumahan and local-fresh galunggong lalaki were provided by PFDA. Meanwhile, price data of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki were gathered through FIDSSD's price monitoring at Navotas Fish Port.
