<b>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of October:</b> 1. Due to the unfavorable weather conditions brought by tropical cyclones "Julian," "Kristine," and "Leon," an unsteady but sufficient availability of fresh marine commodities was recorded among the monitored retail markets this month. Consequently, the prevailing retail price of medium-sized, local-fresh galunggong lalaki ( <i>Decapterus macrosoma</i> ) increased from Php 260.00/kg last month to Php 300.00/kg and Php 320.00/kg this month, with supplies sourced primarily from Malabon and Navotas Fish Port. 2. An increased supply of medium-sized, imported-frozen galunggong lalaki ( <i>D. macrosoma</i> ) was recorded this month at prevailing retail prices of Php 190.00/kg and Php 240.00/kg, primarily sourced from Navotas Fish Port. Other imported-frozen commodities, such as galunggong babae, pampano, salmon head and belly, meat, and pusit kalawang, were also noted in the monitored markets. 3. Unpredictable availability of medium-sized alumahan ( <i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i> ) was still observed among the monitored retail markets this week. The recorded prevailing retail price of Php260.00/kg was recorded in primary types of market specifically in Malabon. 4. For tilapia ( <i>Oreochromis niloticus</i> ), a stable and sufficient supply was still observed among the monitored retail markets. The prevailing retail price of medium-sized tilapia remained at Php 140.00/kg this month. A Php 20-30/kg price difference still exists between live and fresh-chilled tilapia. 5. For bangus ( <i>Chanos chanos</i> ), constant supplies from major source areas were still observed among the monitored retail markets this month. The prevailing retail price of medium-sized bangus remained steady at Php 180.00/kg. Nonetheless, some fish vendors in Muñoz, Trabajo, Galas, and Tandang Sora prefer selling larger-sized bangus due to higher consumer demand. 6. Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: a. Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan b. Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga c. Local Galunggong - Malabon Fish Port, Lucena Quezon d. Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port e. Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port 7. <b>Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena.</b>  <i>Penaeus monodon</i> (Sugpo, Large to Jumbo) – Php 900-1000/kg- The lowest prevailing price of Php 900.00/kg was recorded in the third and fourth weeks at Polo and Marikina markets, where supplies were relatively small at 14 to 15 pcs/kg. This was compared to the highest prevailing retail price, recorded in the second and fifth weeks at Commonwealth Market, where supplies were larger at 12 pcs/kg or below. <i>Thunnus albacares</i> (Tambakol, Sliced) – Php 300-500/kg- The lowest prevailing price of Php 300.00/kg was recorded in the second and third weeks at Commonwealth, Pasig, and Maypajo retail markets, where the supply was sourced directly from nearby fish ports and was of lower quality (supplies from previous days), hence the lower price. The highest prevailing price of Php 500.00/kg was recorded in the fourth and fifth weeks at Guadalupe Market, a secondary market, where supplies were sourced only from primary markets, resulting in the higher price. <i>Scomberomorus commerson</i> (Tangigue, Whole) – Php 300-400/kg- The lowest prevailing price of Php 300.00/kg was recorded in the second and third weeks at the primary markets of Balintawak and Malabon, where supplies were sourced directly from nearby fish ports. The highest prevailing price of Php 400.00/kg was recorded in the fourth and fifth weeks at Guadalupe Market, a secondary market, where supplies were sourced only from primary markets, leading to the higher price. <i>Cypselurus</i> sp. (Iliw) – Php 160-300/kg- Both the lowest and highest prevailing prices were recorded in the fourth week at Mega-Q Market. The lowest price of Php 160.00/kg was noted to be smaller-sized of the commodity, while the highest price of Php 300.00/kg was noted to be larger-sized of the commodity. <i>Dendrophysa russelii</i> (Akaak) – Php 100-240/kg- The lowest prevailing retail price of Php 100.00/kg was recorded in the first week at Pasig Market, where supplies were mostly small-sized. The highest prevailing price of Php 240.00/kg was recorded in the second week at Muñoz Market, where supplies were mostly large-sized. <i>Leiopotherapon plumbeus</i> (Ayungin) – Php 260-360/kg- The lowest prevailing retail price of Php 260.00/kg was recorded in the second week at Muñoz Market, where supplies were smaller in size. The highest prevailing price of Php 360.00/kg was recorded at Marikina Market, where larger-sized supplies were available, resulting in higher demand and a higher price. <i>Pterocaesio tile</i> (Dalagang Bukid Bilog) – Php 200-360/kg- The lowest prevailing retail price of Php 200.00/kg was recorded in the fourth week at Commonwealth Market, where supplies were in excess from previous market days.
