Remarks/Market Observations:			<p>The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of October:</p> <p>1. Minimal but sufficient availability of fresh marine commodities was observed this month at the Navotas Fish Port wholesale market due to the unfavorable weather conditions brought by tropical cyclones "Julian," "Kristine," and "Leon," which hampered fishing activities in the country. As a result, an increase in the prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized local fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) was observed, rising from an average of Php 166.00/kg last month (September) to Php 200.00/kg this month. Supplies were sourced from various provinces such as Mindoro, Palawan, and Zambales.</p> <p>2. Imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (<i>D. macrosoma</i>) remained notable at Navotas Fish Port this month following the increase in the prevailing wholesale price of the local-fresh variant. These supplies were imported from Vietnam. Other variants of the commodity, such as imported-frozen galunggong babae (<i>D. russelli</i>), were also recorded.</p> <p>3. For alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>), only the second and third weeks showed the presence of this commodity, with actual wholesale prices recorded at Php 125.00/kg and Php 131.00/kg, respectively. Supplies were sourced from the provinces of Quezon and Palawan.</p> <p>4. For aquaculture commodities like bangus (<i>Chanos chano s</i>) and tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>), stable and sufficient supplies were still observed this month at Navotas Fish Port.</p> <p>6. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Bangus - Bulacan & Pangasinan b. Tilapia - Batangas & Pampanga c. Local-fresh galunggong - d. Alumahan - Quezon Province, Palawan e. Imported-frozen galunggong - Vietnam
