Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- A limited volume of fishery commodities were recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. This may be attributed to the inclement weather caused by Typhoon "Nika", which hampered fishing operations and delayed the delivery of fishery supplies from nearby regions. Despite this, an adequate unloading of medium-sized local fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was recorded, with five brokers unloading on November 12, 2024 and five more on November 15, 2024. The recorded wholesale price ranged from Php 113.00 to Php 200.00 per kilogram, sourced from Zambales, Zamboanga and Palawan.
- In spite the supplies of local variant, unloading of medium-sized imported frozen galunggong lalaki (*D. macrosoma*) remain observed at the fish port this week, sold at a prevailing wholesale price of Php 155.00/kg, while imported galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) was sold at Php 145.00/kg, both sourced from Vietnam.
- Meanwhile, only one (1) broker unloaded alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*) at Navotas Fish Port this week. The recorded actual wholesale price was Php 140.00 per kilogram, sourced from Zambales.
- In contrast, sufficient availability of bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) was noted this week at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). For medium-sized bangus, the prevailing wholesale prices were Php 100.00 and Php 110.00 per kilogram, sourced from Bulacan. Additionally, supplies of large-sized bangus were recorded at the fish port, sourced from Pangasinan, Bulacan, Laguna and Batangas. For medium-sized tilapia (*O. niloticus*), the prevailing wholesale price was Php 115.00 per kilogram, predominantly sourced from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Palawan
 - Alumahan- Zambales
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam

Note: Price data of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki were gathered through FIDSSD's price monitoring at Navotas Fish Port.

 (**) - Actual Price - refers to the prices in the absence of the most frequently occurring value per fresh fishery commodity per sampling size at a given time.
