Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of July:</p> <p>1. Overall, limited availability of fresh marine commodities was noted in the monitored markets this month. This can be attributed to the occurrence of several typhoons, including Typhoon Marce, Typhoon Nika, Super Typhoon Ofel, and Super Typhoon Pepito, which hindered fishing operations and fish deliveries. Specifically, a reduced supply of medium-sized local fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) was recorded, which may continue to be affected by the ongoing fishing ban (closed fishing season) in Northeastern Palawan, a major fishing ground. The prevailing retail price was Php260.00/kg.</p> <p>2. The availability of medium-sized imported frozen galunggong lalaki (<i>D. macrosoma</i>) was still observed in the markets of Trabajo, Quinta, Commonwealth, Balintawak, Muñoz, Galas, Maypajo, and Polo with a prevailing retail price of Php240.00/kg. These were sourced predominantly from Navotas Fish Port. Other imported fishery commodities, such as silver pompano (<i>Trachinotus blochii</i>), pusit kalawang (<i>Todarodes</i> sp.), chub mackerel (<i>Scomber japonicus</i>), Atlantic salmon (<i>Salmo salar</i>), and others, were also recorded.</p> <p>3. Limited displays of alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) were seen in the monitored markets this month. Meanwhile, large-sized alumahan remained the majority of the supply, mainly sourced from Malabon and Navotas Fish Port. Additionally, hasa-hasa (<i>Rastrelliger brachysoma</i>) was consistently available in the monitored markets.</p> <p>4. Stable and sufficient availability of major aquaculture commodities such as bangus and tilapia was recorded in the monitored retail markets this month. For medium-sized bangus (<i>Chanos chanos</i>), the prevailing retail price was Php160.00 & 180.00/kg, primarily sourced from Bulacan. Similarly, for medium-sized tilapia (<i>Oreochromis niloticus</i>), the prevailing retail price remained at Php130.00/kg, with supplies sourced from Pampanga and Batangas.</p> <p>5.
