Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of November:

- A limited supply of marine fishery commodities was observed this November. This is likely due to the series of typhoons that entered the country, including Typhoon "Marce" from November 4-8, 2024; Typhoon "Nika" from November 9-12, 2024; Super Typhoon "Ofel" from November 12-15, 2024; and Super Typhoon "Pepito" from November 14-18, 2024. These typhoons likely caused delays in fishing operations and fish deliveries to the major fish ports in Metro Manila. More specifically, a limited supply of local fresh galunggong lakaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was observed at the Navotas Fish Port this month, possibly due to the cold weather brought by the northeast monsoon and various typhoons as well as the ongoing fishing ban (closed fishing season) in the northeastern part of Palawan, a major fishing ground. The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized commodity was Php200.00/kg, with supplies sourced from Zambales, Zamboanga, and Palawan.
- Consequently, the unloading of imported frozen medium-sized galunggong lakaki (*D. macrosoma*) and abaa (*D. russelli*) was still observed at the fish port this month both recorded a prevailing wholesale price of Php150.00/kg, with supplies mainly sourced from Vietnam and China.
- On the other hand, a limited supply of medium-sized alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*) was observed this month at the Navotas Fish Port. The prevailing wholesale price was Php180.00/kg, with supplies sourced from Zambales, Zamboanga, Quezon Province, and Palawan.
- For aquaculture commodities, an ample supply of medium-sized bangus (*Chanos chanos*) was observed at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month, with prevailing wholesale prices of Php100.00, Php110.00, and Php120.00/kg. The supplies were sourced from Bulacan, Pangasinan, Batangas, and Laguna. Similarly, supplies of medium-sized tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) remained sufficient, with a prevailing wholesale price of Php115.00/kg, predominantly sourced from Batangas and Pampanga.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Palawan, Zamboanga, Zambales
 - Imported-frozen galunggong - Vietnam, China
 - Alumahan- Zamboanga and Zambales,
