Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- For fresh marine commodities, minimal supplies were unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. This may be attributed to the cold weather condition wherein fishes tend to go at the bottom of the ocean making them harder to catch.
- For medium-sized local-fresh galunggong laki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), lesser supplies were observed this week. This resulted to a higher prevailing wholesale price at Php200.00/kg this week. Supplies were mostly sourced from Palawan, Zambales, Batangas and Zamboanga. There were other variants of local galunggong, such as galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) and burot (*Decapterus kurroides*), were also observed at the fish port.
- More supplies of imported-frozen galunggong was recorded at Navotas Fish Port this week. Due to the high prevailing wholesale price of local galunggong, most of the buyers switched to sell imported-frozen variant.
- No unloading of supply were recorded for alumahan this week.
- The prevailing wholesale price of bangus and tilapia remained at Php105 & 110/kg and Php100/kg this week. This may be attributed to the stable and sufficient supplies unloaded at the fish port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan, Laguna
 - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
 - Local galunggong- Zambales, Zamboanga, Palawan
 - Alumahan- NA
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam
