Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Minimal unloading of fresh marine commodities were recorded in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Particularly, minimal unloading of medium-sized, local fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was recorded, with only one (1) broker unloaded a total of 800 kilograms both on December 31, 2024, and January 3, 2025. The recorded actual wholesale prices were from Php 190.00 and Php 220.00 per kilogram, with the supplies sourced from Zambales.
- On the other hand, adequate unloading of medium-sized imported galunggong lalaki (*D. macrosoma*) was noted at the fish port week, sold at a prevailing wholesale price of Php 180.00/kg, while imported galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) was sold at Php 130.00/kg, both sourced from Vietnam¹.
- Similar to other marine commodities, limited unloading of alumahan (*Rastriliger kanagurta*) was recorded at Navotas Fish Port this week with the recorded actual wholesale price of Php110.00 & 220.00/kg, with the supplies sourced from Bataan and Masbate.
- For major aquaculture commodities such as (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*), stable and adequate supply was recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. The actual wholesale prices for medium-sized bangus were at Php 110.00 and Php 115.00 per kilogram, sourced from Bulacan. Meanwhile, for medium-sized tilapia (*O. niloticus*), the prevailing wholesale prices were at Php 100.00 and Php 110.00 per kilogram, predominantly sourced from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Zambales
 - Alumahan- Bataan and Masbate
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam

¹ Price data of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki were gathered through FIDSSD's price monitoring at Navotas Fish Port.

(**) - Actual Price - refers to the prices in the absence of the most frequently occurring value per fresh fishery commodity per sampling size at a given time.
