**The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:**

- Generally, minimal but sufficient availability of fresh-marine commodities was still observed today among the monitored retail markets. As per interviewed market fish vendors said the minimal supplies were still due to Northeast monsoon "amihan" which can bring cloudy skies and rains across the country, hindering fishing activity. With this, the prices of marine fishery commodities remain high today. Consequently, for medium-sized galunggong-lalaki (*Decapterus macrossoma*), limited availability was still observed today at maintained prevailing retail price of Php280.00/kg, sourced majorly from Zamboanga.
- Meanwhile, supplies of the imported frozen variant of the commodity remain prevalent among the monitored retail markets, as it is more vendor's preferred due to its cheaper price, which enables them to sell easily.
- Still, for medium-sized alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*), inadequate availability was observed among the monitored retail markets today at prevailing retail of Php240.00/kg, sourced primarily from Malabon fish port. Moreover, larger size of this commodity at (roughly 7-10pcs/kg) is much commonly observed in some of the monitored retail markets such as Quinta, Commonwealth, Mega-Q, and Farmers.
- Steady prices of major aquaculture commodities such as bangus (*Chanos chanos*) and tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) were still recorded among the monitored markets as the supplies of these commodities remain adequate to meet the demand of the buying public.
- Top fishery commodities in the seventeen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga
  - Local Galunggong - Malabon Fish Port
  - Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port
